## KIT INSTRUCTIONS (NOTE: size and \# of pieces may vary based on

 the amount of fabric available)- The fabric in this kit has been precut for you
- Use generous $1 / 4$ " seams
- Fabric $A$ is the feature fabric
- If you would like to make another quilt, we have included cutting instructions below
- Press seams from top of quilt (not back) to avoid tucks. Then press from back to get seams to lay flat
- Return quilt top in plastic bag provided


## ALL BLOCK KID'S QUILT

## 40" x 56"

- Fabric A - cut 5 strips $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF, sub-cut into $18-81 / 21$ squares
- Fabric B - cut 5 strips $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF
- Fabric C - cut 5 strips $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF
- Create a strip set by sewing a strip of fabric B to a strip of Fabric C, sub-cut strip sets into $1781 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to create the 4 -patches ( $D$ in chart)
- Iron the 4-patch flat spinning the seams
- Assemble rows alternating Fabric A and 4-patch (annotated as D in chart)
- Row 1 - iron seams to the left
- Row 2 - iron seams to the right
- Continue each following row by alternating the direction that you iron the seams. Refer to arrows in chart
- Sew rows together nesting the seams in each row
- Iron row seams down (see chart)
